Land Tenure.

Two factors affecting the shed's tenure to the land at 164 Diamond Head Road have recently changed.

2. Additional documentation indicating the intentions of the former land owners has been made available to the LMS Management Committee.

In light of these changes, the proposal for land transfer to the Shed in 2020 will be revised and re-presented to ADBRI.

Meanwhile, after the subdivision issues have been resolved by the landlord, the new lease proposed by ADBRI will be the alternative option if the land transfer is not completed by the end of the current lease.


